SAMPLE INTRODUCTION:

"I would like to introduce today's performance which is presented by the Music Center of Los Angeles County. This performance is entitled "AMERICANA UNLIMITED: BEATRIX POTTER and features actress Judith Helton."

"Do you remember The Tale of Peter Rabbit? The creator of Peter Rabbit and his many friends is here with us today. Beatrix Potter has come to our school to share stories about her girlhood in Victorian England and how she became a writer. Please welcome that writer and painter: Ms. Beatrix Potter!"



PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE DAY:

Space:

- 12' wide x 8' deep minimum.
- Portable stages must be sturdy and securely lashed, with steps leading up to the stage.

Surface:

- Freshly mopped (not waxed)
- Irregularities covered with tape
- Extraneous clutter removed.

Dressing Area:

- One private, secured dressing room (not a restroom) will be needed.
- The artist must change into costume upon arrival, so please be sure this room is open and ready for her to use.

Equipment:

- Please have the following set up, cleared and ready before the artist arrives:
- One 6' wide table

ON PERFORMANCE DAY:

Arrival:

- One hour before start time.
- The artist will need to get into costume and set up the performance area.

Parking:

- One space near the venue to facilitate loading and unloading.

Assistance:

- **IMPORTANT:** Please have a school representative ready to welcome the performer and to stay and help as needed.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** The school representative assigned to meet the artist should be able to unlock any doors and turn on power and lights in the performance area.

Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the venue, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
