MUSIC·CENTER

PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE DAY:

Space:

- 10' x 10' minimum.
- Portable stages must be sturdy and securely lashed.

Surface:

- Freshly mopped (not waxed)
- Irregularities covered with tape
- Extraneous clutter removed.

Dressing Area:

- One private, secured dressing room will be needed.

Outdoor Performances:

- The performance area should be shaded, sheltered from wind, and away from distractions.
- Sound equipment provided by the school should be sufficient to reach the audience in an outdoor setting.

Equipment:

- 2 (or more) high quality microphones (Shure microphones are best)
- 2 (or more) microphone stands (preferably boom stands)
- 1 public address system of at least 250 watts, with 2 or more inputs
- 2 speakers
- 1 music stand
- 1 stool

ON PERFORMANCE DAY:

Arrival:

- 15-30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time to prepare and set up.

Parking:

- One space near the venue for loading and unloading.

Assistance:

- Please have a school representative ready to welcome the performers and to stay and help as needed.

Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the venue, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
